A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to copayments required by a health maintenance 3 organization or preferred provider benefit plan for visiting 4 physical therapists.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 843.212 to read as follows:

8 <u>Sec. 843.212. PHYSICAL THERAPIST COPAYMENT LIMIT. A health</u> 9 <u>care plan that requires an enrollee to pay a copayment for an office</u> 10 <u>visit with the enrollee's primary care physician or provider may</u> 11 <u>not charge a higher copayment amount to that enrollee for an office</u> 12 <u>visit with a physical therapist.</u>

SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Section 1301.166 to read as follows:

Sec. 1301.166. PHYSICAL THERAPIST COPAYMENT LIMIT. A
preferred provider benefit plan that requires an insured to pay a
copayment for an office visit with the insured's primary care
physician or provider may not charge a higher copayment amount to
that insured for an office visit with a physical therapist.

20 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 21 a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on 22 or after January 1, 2022.

23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
