4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 102.002, Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 102.002. CONTENTS OF APPLICATION. An application for
8	a late ballot must <u>:</u>
9	(1) be in the form of an affidavit; and
10	(2) comply with the applicable provisions of Section
11	84.002 [and must include or be accompanied by a certificate of a
12	licensed physician or chiropractor or accredited Christian Science
13	practitioner in substantially the following form:
14	["This is to certify that I know that has a
15	sickness or physical condition that will prevent him or her from
16	appearing at the polling place for an election to be held on the
17	day of, 19, without a likelihood of
18	needing personal assistance or of injuring his or her health and

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
