## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the requirement that certain business entities obtain a
3	license from the Texas Real Estate Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1101.355, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
7	(d) Notwithstanding Subsection (c) or any other law, a
8	business entity is not required to be licensed under this chapter if
9	the business entity:
10	(1) receives compensation on behalf of a broker or
11	sales agent licensed under this chapter that is earned by the
12	license holder while engaged in real estate brokerage;
13	(2) performs no other acts of a broker;
14	<u>(3) is:</u>
15	(A) a limited liability company as defined by
16	Section 101.001, Business Organizations Code; or
17	(B) an S corporation as defined by 26 U.S.C.
18	Section 1361;
19	(4) is registered with the commission; and
20	(5) is at least 51 percent owned by the license holder
21	on whose behalf the entity receives compensation.
22	(e) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the
23	registration of a business entity described by Subsection (d).
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
