## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to annulment of a marriage on the grounds of fraud, duress,
- 3 or force.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.107, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 6.107. FRAUD, DURESS, OR FORCE. The court may grant an
- 8 annulment of a marriage to a party to the marriage if:
- 9 (1) the other party used fraud, duress, or force to
- 10 induce the petitioner to enter into the marriage; and
- 11 (2) the petitioner ceased cohabitation with the other
- 12 party not more than one year after the petitioner learned of the
- 13 <u>fraud or was released from the duress or force and</u> has not
- 14 voluntarily cohabited with the other party since ceasing
- 15 cohabitation [learning of the fraud or since being released from
- 16 the duress or force].
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a suit for dissolution of a marriage that is filed on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act. A suit for dissolution of a marriage
- 20 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 21 in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is
- 22 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
