3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 552.221, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows:
6	(f) If the governmental body determines it has no
7	information responsive to a request for information, the officer
8	for public information shall notify the requestor in writing not
9	later than the 10th business day after the date the request is
10	received.
11	(g) If a governmental body determines the requested
12	information is subject to a previous determination that permits or
13	requires the governmental body to withhold the requested
14	information, the officer for public information shall, not later
15	than the 10th business day after the date the request is received:
16	(1) notify the requestor in writing that the
17	information is being withheld; and
18	(2) identify in the notice the specific previous
19	determination the governmental body is relying on to withhold the
20	requested information.
21	SECTION 2. Section 552.261, Government Code, is amended by
22	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
23	(f) A governmental body may not impose a charge under this
24	subchapter for providing a copy of public information if the

- 2 body under Subchapter C or D, Chapter 254, Election Code, unless all
- 3 of those reports filed with the governmental body during the
- 4 preceding year are available to the public on the governmental
- 5 body's Internet website.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 552.264, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 552.264. COPY OF PUBLIC INFORMATION REQUESTED BY
- 9 MEMBER OF LEGISLATURE. One copy of public information that is
- 10 requested from a political subdivision or a state agency by a
- 11 member, agency, or committee of the legislature under Section
- 12 552.008 shall be provided without charge.
- SECTION 4. Section 552.301(b), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The governmental body must ask for the attorney
- 16 general's decision and state the specific exceptions that apply
- 17 within a reasonable time but not later than the 10th business day
- 18 after the date of receiving the written request.
- 19 SECTION 5. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 552,
- 20 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- SUBCHAPTER H. CIVIL ENFORCEMENT; COMPLAINT
- SECTION 6. Subchapter H, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 552.328 to read as follows:
- Sec. 552.328. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO REQUESTOR. (a) If a
- 25 governmental body fails to respond to a requestor as required by
- 26 Section 552.221, the requestor may send a written complaint to the
- 27 attorney general.

1 (b) The complaint must include: 2 (1) the original request for information; and 3 (2) any correspondence received from the governmental body in response to the request. 4 5 (c) If the attorney general determines the governmental body improperly failed to comply with Section 552.221 in connection 6 7 with a request for which a complaint is made under this section: 8 (1) the attorney general shall notify the governmental body in writing and require the governmental body to complete open 9 10 records training not later than six months after receiving the notification; 11 12 (2) the governmental body may not assess costs to the requestor for producing information in response to the request; and 13 (3) if the governmental body seeks to withhold 14 15 information in response to the request, the governmental body must: 16 (A) request an attorney general decision under 17 Section 552.301 not later than the fifth business day after the date the governmental body receives the notification under Subdivision 18 19 (1); and (B) release the requested information unless 20 there is a compelling reason to withhold the information. 21 SECTION 7. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 22 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or 23 24 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of 25 this Act.
