- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
- 9 the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations, and
- 10 regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
- 11 proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law.
- 12 (b) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
- 13 by the governor under this chapter may not suspend a provision in
- 14 the Code of Criminal Procedure or Penal Code.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 418.012, Government Code, as amended by
- 16 this Act, applies only to a declaration of a state of disaster
- 17 issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 18 declaration issued before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 20 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
