5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 545.452, Transportation
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.452. EXCLUSIVE REGULATION OF AUTOMATED MOTOR
8	VEHICLES AND AUTOMATED DRIVING SYSTEMS [SUBCHAPTER AND DEPARTMENT
9	GOVERN EXCLUSIVELY].
10	SECTION 2. Section 545.452(a), Transportation Code, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	(a) Unless otherwise provided by this subchapter, automated
13	motor vehicles, including any commercial use or operation of
14	automated motor vehicles, and automated driving systems [the
15	following] are governed exclusively by:
16	(1) this subchapter; and
17	(2) Section 547.618 [÷
18	[(1) automated motor vehicles, including any
19	commercial use or operation of automated motor vehicles; and
20	[(2) automated driving systems].
21	SECTION 3. Subchapter K , Chapter 547 , Transportation Code,
22	is amended by adding Section 547.618 to read as follows:
23	Sec. 547.618. EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR DEDICATED AUTONOMOUS
24	VEHICLE. (a) In this section, "dedicated autonomous vehicle"

- 1 means an automated motor vehicle, as defined by Section 545.451,
- 2 that is incapable of operation by a human operator present in the
- 3 vehicle.
- 4 (b) Notwithstanding any other law and to the extent allowed
- 5 by federal law, a dedicated autonomous vehicle is exempt from:
- 6 (1) the provisions of Section 547.3215 related to
- 7 associated equipment;
- 8 (2) Sections 547.602 and 547.603; and
- 9 (3) Section 547.604, unless the vehicle is equipped
- 10 with an internal combustion engine.
- 11 (c) If a vehicle safety inspection is required under this
- 12 code for the operation of a dedicated autonomous vehicle, the
- 13 <u>inspection may not include any equipment:</u>
- 14 (1) the requirements from which the vehicle is exempt
- 15 under Subsection (b); or
- 16 (2) the inspection of which is not required under
- 17 Section 548.051.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
