 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 382, Health and Safety Code, is amended

 6 by adding Subchapter L to read as follows:

 7 SUBCHAPTER L. REGULATION OF HYDROFLUOROCARBONS
- 8 Sec. 382.551. SUBSTITUTES FOR HYDROFLUOROCARBON
- 9 REFRIGERANTS APPLICABLE TO COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS OR
- 10 CONSTRUCTION. A building code or other requirement applicable to
- 11 <u>commercial or residential buildings or construction may not</u>
- 12 prohibit the use of a substitute refrigerant authorized pursuant to
- 13 <u>42 U.S.C. 7671k.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
