## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a statewide homelessness data
3	system.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter KK, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2306.911 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.911. STATEWIDE HOMELESSNESS DATA SYSTEM. (a)
8	The council shall collaborate with a state agency designated by the
9	council to establish a statewide homelessness data system through
10	which:
11	(1) state agencies, local governmental entities,
12	including law enforcement agencies, court systems, school
13	districts, and emergency service providers, and other relevant
14	persons are able to share information related to individuals
15	experiencing homelessness; and
16	(2) the persons described by Subdivision (1) and
17	members of the public are able to access information related to
18	individuals experiencing homelessness in order to connect or refer
19	those individuals to services, including affordable housing
20	opportunities.
21	(b) In developing the data system, the council and the state
22	agency designated by the council shall:
23	(1) consult with representatives of the entities
24	described by Subsection (a) to determine the challenges faced by

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those entities in addressing homelessness and how best to improve 1 2 the responses to those challenges; 3 (2) enter into data sharing agreements as necessary exchange of information relating to individuals 4 for the 5 experiencing homelessness through the data system; and 6 (3) ensure that information stored in the data system 7 that is confidential under state or federal law is not disclosed. 8 (c) The data system established under this section must: (1) to the extent permitted by a data sharing 9 agreement, collect data from other homelessness data systems 10 maintained or operated by a state agency, local law enforcement 11 12 agency, or other entity of this state; and (2) collect, aggregate, analyze, and 13 share 14 homelessness information submitted to the data system with entities 15 that have access to the system. 16

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16 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2023, the Texas 17 Interagency Council for the Homeless described by Subchapter KK, 18 Chapter 2306, Government Code, or an entity designated by the 19 council shall prepare and submit to the legislature and the Texas 20 Department of Housing and Community Affairs a written report that 21 evaluates the effectiveness of the statewide homelessness data 22 system established under Section 2306.911, Government Code, as 23 added by this Act, in addressing homelessness in this state.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
