4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 24, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 24.012 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 24.012. TEMPORARY ABATEMENT OF EVICTION DURING AND
8	AFTER DISASTER. (a) In this section, "state of disaster" means a
9	state of disaster declared by the governor under Section 418.014,
10	Government Code.
11	(b) This section applies only to an eviction based on a
12	tenant's nonpayment of rent.
13	(c) An action under this chapter to evict a tenant is
14	automatically abated without a court order during the period a
15	state of disaster is in effect and until the 61st day after the date
16	a state of disaster ends.
17	(d) During the period a state of disaster is in effect and
18	until the 61st day after the date a state of disaster ends, an
19	officer may not execute a writ of possession relating to the
20	eviction of a tenant.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
