A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the adoption and review of certain workers'
- 3 compensation guidelines, protocols, and formulary.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 413.011, Labor Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(j)</u> The commissioner by rule may at any time amend or
- 8 replace the treatment guidelines, return-to-work guidelines, or
- 9 individual treatment protocols adopted under Subsection (e) or the
- 10 formulary adopted as described by Section 408.028(b) to ensure that
- 11 the guidelines, protocols, and formulary are current and comply
- 12 with the requirements of this section.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than July 1, 2022, the
- 14 commissioner of workers' compensation shall contract with an
- 15 independent entity to conduct a comparative evaluation of the
- 16 treatment guidelines, return-to-work guidelines, and individual
- 17 treatment protocols adopted by the commissioner under Section
- 18 413.011(e), Labor Code, and the formulary adopted by the
- 19 commissioner as described by Section 408.028(b), Labor Code, and
- 20 report the findings of the evaluation to the commissioner.
- 21 (b) The commissioner of workers' compensation shall ensure
- 22 that the entity conducting the evaluation under Subsection (a) of
- 23 this section does not have a conflict of interest that would
- 24 adversely impact the entity's independence and impartiality,

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- 1 including any financial interest in a developer or publisher of any
- 2 guideline considered in the evaluation. The entity conducting the
- 3 evaluation may not participate in the development of any guideline
- 4 considered in the evaluation.
- 5 (c) Based on the results of the comparative evaluation
- 6 conducted under Subsection (a) of this section, the commissioner of
- 7 workers' compensation shall determine whether the treatment
- 8 guidelines, return-to-work guidelines, or individual treatment
- 9 protocols adopted by the commissioner under Section 413.011(e),
- 10 Labor Code, or the formulary adopted by the commissioner as
- 11 described by Section 408.028(b), Labor Code, should be amended.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
