A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting billboards on cemetery property; providing
 3 a civil penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 711.013 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 711.013. PROHIBITING BILLBOARDS ON CEMETERY PROPERTY.
- 8 (a) In this section, "billboard" means a separate and fixed
- 9 structure directly attached to the land or a building having one or
- 10 more spaces used to display an advertisement, whether or not the
- 11 structure is artificially lighted.

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- 12 (b) A person may not erect or maintain a billboard on
- 13 cemetery property. A cemetery organization may not enter into a
- 14 contract or lease authorizing a billboard on cemetery property.
- (c) The attorney general may bring an action against a
- 16 person who appears to be in violation of this section or is
- 17 threatening to violate this section. In an injunction issued under
- 18 this section, a court may include reasonable requirements to
- 19 prevent any further violations of this section.
- 20 (d) In addition to the injunctive relief provided by
- 21 Subsection (c), the attorney general may institute an action for
- 22 civil penalties against a person for a violation of this section. A
- 23 civil penalty assessed under this section may not exceed \$1,000 for
- 24 each violation. Each day a violation occurs or continues to occur is

- 1 a separate violation for purposes of assessing a penalty under this
- 2 section.
- 3 (e) The attorney general may recover reasonable expenses
- 4 incurred in bringing an action under this section, including court
- 5 costs, attorney's fees, investigative costs, witness fees, and
- 6 deposition expenses.
- 7 (f) The attorney general shall file an action under this
- 8 section in Travis County or in the county in which the violation
- 9 occurred.
- 10 (g) A civil penalty recovered in an action by the attorney
- 11 general under this section shall be deposited in the general
- 12 revenue fund.
- SECTION 2. (a) A billboard prohibited by Section 711.013,
- 14 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, that was erected on
- 15 cemetery property under a contract or lease entered into before the
- 16 effective date of this Act, must be dismantled or removed from the
- 17 cemetery on the expiration date of the existing contract or lease
- 18 between the cemetery organization and the billboard owner or
- 19 lessee, if applicable.
- 20 (b) A cemetery organization may not renew a contract or
- 21 lease for a billboard on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
