| 14 | The term does not include a rule adopted by a state agency. |
| 15 | (2) "State agency" means a board, commission, council, |
| 16 | department, office, or other agency in the executive branch of |
| 17 | state government. |
| 18 | Sec. 2062.0002. LIBERAL CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This |
| 19 | chapter shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purposes. |
| 20 | Sec. 2062.0003. ACCESS TO GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS. (a) Each |
| 21 | state agency shall include on the agency's publicly accessible |
| 22 | Internet website a prominently displayed link to the guidance |

documents issued by the agency.
