## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the identification of and funding for interregional
- 3 water projects.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 16.052, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 16.052. INTERREGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL. (a) The
- 8 board[ , at an appropriate time in each five-year cycle for the
- 9 adoption of a new state water plan, shall appoint an interregional
- 10 planning council. The members of the council serve at the pleasure
- 11 of the board [until a new state water plan is adopted].
- 12 (b) The council consists of one member of each regional
- 13 water planning group. Each regional water planning group shall
- 14 nominate one or more members for appointment to the council, and the
- 15 board shall consider the nominations in making appointments to the
- 16 council. Members of the council shall select one member as
- 17 presiding officer.
- 18 (c) The purposes of the council are to:
- 19 (1) improve coordination among the regional water
- 20 planning groups, and between each regional water planning group and
- 21 the board, in meeting the goals of the state water planning process
- 22 and the water needs of the state as a whole;
- 23 (2) facilitate dialogue regarding water management
- 24 strategies that could affect multiple regional water planning

- 1 areas; [and]
- 2 (3) identify and propose water projects for the state
- 3 water plan that involve multiple water planning areas;
- 4 (4) develop proposals for innovative funding
- 5 mechanisms for projects identified under Subdivision (3); and
- 6 (5) share best practices regarding operation of the
- 7 regional, interregional, and state water planning processes
- 8 [process].
- 9 (d) The council shall:
- 10 (1) hold at least one public meeting; and
- 11 (2) prepare a report to the board on the council's
- 12 work, including projects and funding methods proposed under
- 13 Subsections (c)(3) and (4).
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
