7	Sec. 35.0021. ALTERNATIVE POWER SUPPLY FOR INTERMITTENT							
8	POWER GENERATION FACILITIES. (a) In this section, "intermittent							
9	power generation facility" means a power generation facility with a							
10	power output that, in the course of the facility's ordinary and							
11	proper operation, cannot be predicted, controlled, or varied at							
12	will. The term includes a solar or wind generation facility.							
13	(b) An intermittent power generation facility, the							
14	construction of which began after September 1, 2021, may not							
15	operate in this state unless the owner of the facility certifies to							
16	the commission that, in the event of a power output disruption at							
17	the facility:							
18	(1) the owner can supply or has a contract that							
19	guarantees the supply of not less than 50 percent of the facility's							
20	average output over a 48-hour period; and							
21	(2) the owner's additional or contracted power supply							
22	comes from:							
23	(A) a power generation facility with a power							
24	output that, in the course of the facility's ordinary and proper
