4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 101A.151, Human Resources Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
7	(2-a) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
8	Commission.
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 101A, Human Resources
10	Code, is amended by adding Section 101A.1541 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 101A.1541. HOME-DELIVERED MEAL SERVICES: EVALUATION
12	AND MONITORING. (a) On a quarterly basis the commission shall
13	evaluate the use of home-delivered meal services under the Options
14	for Independent Living program by collecting data from all local
15	area agencies on aging to determine:
16	(1) the number of:
17	(A) home-delivered meals requested under the
18	program;
19	(B) requests for home-delivered meals that are
20	approved and denied under the program; and
21	(C) home-delivered meals that are delivered to
22	individuals under the program; and
23	(2) statewide trends related to the provision of
24	home-delivered meals under the program and the reasons for those

- 2 (b) The commission shall continually monitor the use of
- 3 home-delivered meal services under the Options for Independent
- 4 Living program, including statewide trends related to the use of
- 5 those services, and make any necessary actions to improve the
- 6 provision of those services.
- 7 (c) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission
- 8 shall:
- 9 (1) submit a report containing the results of the
- 10 evaluations performed under Subsection (a) and recommendations for
- 11 improving the use of home-delivered meals under the Options for
- 12 Independent Living program to the governor, the lieutenant
- 13 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 14 standing committees of the legislature having primary jurisdiction
- 15 over health and human services; and
- 16 (2) post the report on the commission's Internet
- 17 website.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2021, the Health and
- 19 Human Services Commission shall submit the report required by
- 20 Section 101A.1541(c), Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
