4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 533.005, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding subsection (a)(27-29)to read as follows:
7	(27) a requirement that the managed care organization
8	perform routine screening of recipients to identify social
9	determinants of health including:
10	(A) housing;
11	(B) education;
12	(C) economic opportunity; and
13	(D) community conditions including access to
14	healthy food, environmental conditions, and safety from crime;
15	(28) a requirement that the managed care organization
16	coordinate with local community services and other federal, state,
17	and local government agencies as applicable to help address the
18	social determinants of health identified in subsection (27) that
19	are affecting the health of the recipient; and
20	(29) a requirement that the managed care organization
21	have a designated social determinants of health specialists for
22	each service area they are contracted in.
23	SECTION 2. This Act does not apply to contracts entered in
24	to before the effective date but applies to all contracts that are

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- 1 new, renewed, or extended on or after the effective date.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
