- 5 Sec. 577A.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
- 6 (1) a mental hospital; or
- 7 (2) a private mental hospital or other mental health

- 6 Sec. 577A.054. ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATE. (a)

- Sec. 577A.055. INSPECTIONS. In addition to the inspections
- 24 required under Section 577A.054, the commission shall conduct an
- 25 <u>inspection not later than the first anniversary of the date a</u>
- 26 certificate is issued or renewed to ensure the certificate holder
- 27 remains in compliance with the requirements of this chapter and

4	Sec. 577A.101. MINIMUM STANDARDS. The executive		
5	commissioner by rule shall establish minimum standards for the		
6	certification of psychiatric residential youth treatment		
7	facilities under this chapter. The minimum standards must require		
8	a facility to:		
9	(1) obtain accreditation by The Joint Commission, the		
10	Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, the		
11	Council on Accreditation, or another accrediting organization		
12	approved by the commission; and		
13	(2) provide and prescribe guidelines for the provision		
14	of the following activities, treatments, and services:		
15	(A) development and implementation of individual

- 2 Sec. 577A.102. ADMISSION CRITERIA. A facility certified
- 3 under this chapter may <u>not admit or provide treatments or services</u>
- 4 to an individual unless the individual:
- 5 (1) is 21 years of age or younger;
- 6 (2) has been diagnosed with a severe emotional
- 7 disturbance by a licensed mental health professional;
- 8 (3) requires residential psychiatric treatment under
- 9 the direction of a licensed physician to improve the individual's
- 10 condition; and
- 11 (4) was referred for treatments or services in a
- 12 psychiatric residential youth treatment facility by a licensed
- 13 mental health professional.
- 14 SUBCHAPTER D. ENFORCEMENT
- Sec. 577A.151. PENALTIES. A facility certified under this

- Sec. 577.002. EXEMPTIONS [FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT]. (a)
- 22 A mental health facility operated by the department or a federal

- 25 youth treatment facility certified under Chapter 577A.
- SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
