- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 7, Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Chapter 577A to read as follows:
- 9 CHAPTER 577A. PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL YOUTH TREATMENT FACILITIES
- 10 <u>SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS</u>
- Sec. 577A.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 12 <u>(1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services</u>
- 13 <u>Commission</u>.

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- 14 (2) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
- 15 commissioner of the commission.
- 16 (3) "Psychiatric residential youth treatment
- 17 facility" means a private facility that provides psychiatric health
- 18 treatments and services in a residential, nonhospital setting
- 19 <u>exclusively to individuals who are 21 years of age or younger and</u>
- 20 that meets criteria to be licensed as a general residential
- 21 operation under Chapter 42, Human Resources Code. The term
- 22 includes a facility that provides room and board.
- 23 (4) "Severe emotional disturbance" means a mental,
- 24 behavioral, or emotional disorder of sufficient duration to result

- 1 in functional impairment that substantially interferes with or
- 2 limits an individual's role or ability to function in family,
- 3 school, or community activities.
- 4 Sec. 577A.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
- 5 (1) a mental hospital; or
- 6 (2) a private mental hospital or other mental health
- 7 facility licensed under Chapter 577.
- 8 Sec. 577A.003. LICENSING AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS NOT
- 9 AFFECTED. This chapter does not affect any licensing or other
- 10 requirements of a psychiatric residential youth treatment facility
- 11 under Chapter 42, Human Resources Code.
- 12 Sec. 577A.004. RULES. The executive commissioner shall
- 13 adopt rules necessary to implement this chapter.
- 14 SUBCHAPTER B. CERTIFICATION, FEES, AND INSPECTIONS
- 15 Sec. 577A.051. VOLUNTARY QUALITY STANDARDS CERTIFICATION.
- 16 The commission shall develop and implement a voluntary quality
- 17 standards certification process to certify a psychiatric
- 18 residential youth treatment facility that meets standards for
- 19 certification under this chapter.
- Sec. 577A.052. CERTIFICATE APPLICATION. (a) To obtain a
- 21 certificate under this chapter, an applicant must submit to the
- 22 commission an application in the form and manner prescribed by the
- 23 <u>commission</u>.
- (b) Each application must be accompanied by a fee
- 25 established by the executive commissioner under Section 577A.053.
- Sec. 577A.053. FEES. The executive commissioner by rule
- 27 shall establish a nonrefundable certificate application fee and a

- 1 nonrefundable certificate renewal fee in amounts necessary to cover
- 2 the costs of administering this chapter.
- 3 Sec. 577A.054. ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATE. (a)
- 4 The commission shall issue a certificate to an applicant if on
- 5 inspection and investigation the commission determines the
- 6 applicant meets the requirements of this chapter and commission
- 7 rules.
- 8 (b) A certificate issued under this chapter expires on the
- 9 second anniversary of the date the certificate is issued or
- 10 <u>renewed.</u>
- 11 (c) The commission shall renew a certificate if:
- 12 (1) the certificate holder submits to the commission a
- 13 fee established by the executive commissioner under Section
- 14 577A.053; and
- 15 (2) on inspection and investigation the commission
- 16 determines the certificate holder meets the requirements of this
- 17 chapter and commission rules.
- Sec. 577A.055. INSPECTIONS. In addition to the inspections
- 19 required under Section 577A.054, the commission shall conduct an
- 20 inspection not later than the first anniversary of the date a
- 21 certificate is issued or renewed to ensure the certificate holder
- 22 remains in compliance with the requirements of this chapter and
- 23 <u>commission rules.</u>
- 24 SUBCHAPTER C. REGULATION OF CERTIFIED PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL
- 25 YOUTH TREATMENT FACILITIES
- Sec. 577A.101. MINIMUM STANDARDS. The executive
- 27 commissioner by rule shall establish minimum standards for the

- 1 certification of psychiatric residential youth treatment
- 2 facilities under this chapter. The minimum standards must require
- 3 a facility to:
- 4 (1) obtain accreditation by The Joint Commission, the
- 5 Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, the
- 6 Council on Accreditation, or another accrediting organization
- 7 approved by the commission; and
- 8 (2) provide and prescribe guidelines for the provision
- 9 of the following activities, treatments, and services:
- 10 (A) development and implementation of individual
- 11 plans of care, including the provision of services provided by a
- 12 licensed psychiatrist or physician to develop individual plans of
- 13 care;
- 14 (B) individual therapy;
- 15 <u>(C)</u> family engagement activities;
- 16 (D) consultation services with qualified
- 17 professionals, including case managers, primary care
- 18 professionals, community-based mental health providers, school
- 19 staff, and other support planners;
- 20 (E) 24-hour nursing services; and
- 21 <u>(F) direct care and supervision services,</u>
- 22 <u>supportive services for daily living and safety</u>, and positive
- 23 behavior management services.
- Sec. 577A.102. ADMISSION CRITERIA. A facility certified
- 25 under this chapter may not admit or provide treatments or services
- 26 to an individual unless the individual:
- 27 (1) is 21 years of age or younger;

- 1 (2) has been diagnosed with a severe emotional
- 2 disturbance by a licensed mental health professional;
- 3 (3) requires residential psychiatric treatment under
- 4 the direction of a licensed physician to improve the individual's
- 5 condition; and
- 6 (4) was referred for treatments or services in a
- 7 psychiatric residential youth treatment facility by a licensed
- 8 mental health professional.
- 9 SUBCHAPTER D. ENFORCEMENT
- 10 Sec. 577A.151. PENALTIES. A facility certified under this
- 11 chapter is subject to a civil penalty under Section 571.023 or an
- 12 administrative penalty under Section 571.025, as applicable, for a
- 13 violation of this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 577.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 577.002. EXEMPTIONS [FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT]. (a)
- 17 A mental health facility operated by the department or a federal
- 18 agency need not be licensed under this chapter.
- (b) This chapter does not apply to a psychiatric residential
- 20 youth treatment facility certified under Chapter 577A.
- 21 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 22 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 23 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 24 Chapter 577A, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
