## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the career and technology education allotment under the

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 48.106(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily
- 8 attendance in an approved career and technology education program
- 9 in grades 7 through 12, a district is entitled to:
- 10 (1) an annual allotment equal to the basic allotment,
- 11 or, if applicable, the sum of the basic allotment and the allotment
- 12 under Section 48.101 to which the district is entitled, multiplied
- 13 by a weight of 1.35; and
- 14 (2) \$50 for each of the following in which the student
- 15 is enrolled:
- 16 (A) two or more advanced career and technology
- 17 education classes for a total of three or more credits;
- 18 (B) a campus designated as a P-TECH school under
- 19 Section 29.556; or
- (C) a campus that is a member of the New Tech
- 21 Network and that focuses on project-based learning and work-based
- 22 education.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
