The operator of a tow truck preparing to perform a nonconsent tow shall release a vehicle to the owner or 13 operator of the vehicle if: 14 15 (1) the vehicle has not been moved from the site from 16 which it is to be towed; (2) the vehicle is fully prepared to be towed legally 17 over a public road or highway; and 18 (3) the owner or operator of the vehicle pays a fee of 19 not more than \$50 to the operator of the tow truck. 20 21 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2021, the Texas 22 Department of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules as necessary to implement Section 2308.4501, Occupations Code, as 23 24 added by this Act.
