A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to Medicaid reimbursement for dental services provided to

3 certain adults with disabilities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.054, Human Resources Code, is amended

6 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

7 (f) To prevent serious medical conditions and reduce

8 emergency room visits necessitated by complications resulting from

a lack of access to dental care, the commission shall provide

10 medical assistance reimbursement for preventive dental services,

11 <u>including reimbursement for at least one preventive dental care</u>

12 visit per year, for an adult recipient with a disability who is

13 enrolled in the STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care program. This

14 subsection does not apply to an adult recipient who is enrolled in

15 the STAR+PLUS home and community-based services (HCBS) waiver

16 program. This subsection may not be construed to reduce dental

17 services available to persons with disabilities that are otherwise

18 reimbursable under the medical assistance program.

19 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

20 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

22 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

24 waiver or authorization is granted.
