- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 408.001(b) and (c), Labor Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) This section does not prohibit the recovery of exemplary
- 8 damages by the surviving spouse, parents, or heirs of the body of a
- 9 deceased employee whose death was caused by an intentional act or
- 10 omission of the employer or by the employer's gross negligence. $\underline{\mbox{The}}$
- 11 surviving spouse, parents, and heirs of the body of the deceased
- 12 employee may bring the action or one or more of those individuals
- 13 may bring the action for the benefit of all.
- 14 (c) In this section:
- 15 (1) "Gross[, "gross] negligence" has the meaning
- 16 assigned by Section 41.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
- 17 (2) "Parent" includes an adoptive parent or a
- 18 stepparent. The term does not include a parent whose parental
- 19 rights have been terminated.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a
- 22 compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before
- 24 that date is governed by the law in effect on the date that the

- 1 compensable injury occurred, and the former law is continued in
- 2 effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
