10	omission of the employer or by the employer's gross negligence. The
11	surviving spouse, parents, and heirs of the body of the deceased
12	employee may bring the action or one or more of those individuals
13	may bring the action for the benefit of all.
14	(c) In this section:
15	(1) "Gross[ <del>, "gross</del> ] negligence" has the meaning
16	assigned by Section 41.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
17	(2) "Parent" includes an adoptive parent or a
18	stepparent. The term does not include a parent whose parental
19	rights have been terminated.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a
22	compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of
23	this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before
24	that date is governed by the law in effect on the date that the
