H.B. No. 3184

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of adaptive model data analytics software by the
3 independent organization certified to manage the ERCOT power
4 region.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 39.151, Utilities Code, is amended by
7 adding Subsection (g-2) to read as follows:

8 (g-2) To maintain certification as an independent
9 organization under this section, an organization must use adaptive
10 model data analytics software in forecasting power generation
11 system availability.

12 SECTION 2. (a) An independent organization certified under
13 Section 39.151, Utilities Code, by the Public Utility Commission of
14 Texas before September 1, 2021, shall begin to use adaptive model
15 data analytics software to comply with Section 39.151, Utilities
16 Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as practicable, but not later
17 than September 1, 2022.

18 (b) After September 1, 2022, the Public Utility Commission
19 of Texas may decertify an independent organization that does not
20 use adaptive model data analytics software to comply with Section
21 39.151, Utilities Code, as amended by this Act.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
