H.B. No. 3197

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the repair or replacement of certain damaged historical
3 markers by the Texas Historical Commission.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. From money appropriated to the Texas Historical
6 Commission or made available from any other source for the state
7 fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2023, the commission shall spend
8 at least \$50,000 each state fiscal year to repair or replace damaged
9 historical markers and monuments placed at locations throughout
10 this state in celebration of the 1936 Texas Centennial. The
11 commission shall repair damaged markers using materials and styles
12 that closely replicate the original materials and styles. For
13 markers that must be completely reconstructed, the commission shall
14 comply with the United States Department of the Interior standards
15 for sites listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
