15	(2) "Military-style gear" means clothing that is:
16	(A) substantially similar to clothing issued to a
17	member of the military; and
18	(B) necessary or useful for performing a military
19	duty or function.
20	(b) The punishment for an offense described by Subsection
21	(c) is increased to the punishment prescribed for the next higher
22	category of offense if it is shown on the trial of the offense that
