- 19 (3) Standard 380 of the American National Standard for
- 20 Testing Airtightness of Building, Dwelling Unit, and Sleeping Unit
- 21 Enclosures, Airtightness of Heating and Cooling Air Distribution
- 22 Systems, and Airflow of Mechanical Ventilation Systems, commonly
- 23 cited as ANSI/RESNET/ICC 380; and
- 24 (4) the [The] Energy Rating Index Compliance
