1 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act to Chapters 2 521 and 522, Transportation Code, apply only to a driver's license, 3 commercial driver's license, or personal identification 4 certificate issued or renewed under Chapter 521 or 522, 5 Transportation Code, on or after January 1, 2022.

6 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
