- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 455.156, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (b) An applicant for a license under this section must be an
- 9 individual and:
- 10 (1) present evidence satisfactory to the department
- 11 that the person has satisfactorily completed massage therapy
- 12 studies in a 500-hour minimum, supervised course of instruction in
- 13 <u>a manner provided by Subsection (c)</u> [provided by a massage therapy
- 14 instructor at a massage school, a licensed massage school, a
- 15 state-approved educational institution, or any combination of
- 16 instructors or schools], in which at least:
- 17 (A) 200 hours are taught by a licensed massage
- 18 therapy instructor and dedicated to the study of massage therapy
- 19 techniques and theory and the practice of manipulation of soft
- 20 tissue, with at least 125 hours dedicated to the study of Swedish
- 21 massage therapy techniques;
- (B) 50 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 23 anatomy;
- (C) 25 hours are dedicated to the study of

- (D) 50 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 3 kinesiology;
- 4 (E) 40 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 5 pathology;
- 6 (F) 20 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 7 hydrotherapy;
- 8 (G) 45 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 9 massage therapy laws and rules, business practices, and
- 10 professional ethics standards;
- 11 (H) 20 hours are dedicated to the study of
- 12 health, hygiene, first aid, universal precautions, and
- 13 cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR); and
- 14 (I) 50 hours are spent in an internship program;
- 15 (2) pass the required examinations; and
- 16 (3) be at least 18 years of age.
- 17 (c) The hours of instruction required by Subsection (b) must
- 18 be provided by a massage therapy instructor at a massage school,
- 19 licensed massage school, state-approved educational institution,
- 20 or any combination of instructors or schools. The hours of
- 21 <u>instruction required by Subsections (b)(1)(B)-(H) may be provided</u>
- 22 by a massage therapy instructor through a school or institution
- 23 <u>described by this subsection using distance learning.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. An applicant for a massage therapist license may
- 25 satisfy the requirements of Sections 455.156(b)(1)(B)-(H),
- 26 Occupations Code, using distance learning as provided by Section
- 27 455.156(c), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, regardless of

- 1 whether the application is submitted before, on, or after the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
