4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Election Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 1.022 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1.022. ALTERATION OF VOTING STANDARDS, PRACTICES, OR
8	PROCEDURES. (a) An election official of a political subdivision
9	seeking to alter, in response to a pandemic disaster, any voting
10	standard, practice, or procedure in a manner not otherwise
11	expressly authorized by this code, must first obtain approval of
12	the proposed alteration from the secretary of state by submitting a
13	written request for approval to the secretary of state.
14	(b) The secretary of state by written order may approve a
15	proposed alteration requested under Subsection (a). An election
16	official of a political subdivision may not alter any voting
17	standard, practice, or procedure in a manner not otherwise
18	expressly authorized by this code without a written order of
19	approval from the secretary of state.
20	(c) The secretary of state may not approve a request under
21	Subsection (a) or (b) unless a condition directly caused by the
22	disaster which is the subject of a disaster declaration under
23	Chapter 418, Government Code, or another law authorizing the
24	declaration of a disaster, has made the conduct of the election

1 infeasible in the absence of the alteration.

2 <u>(d) In the absence of the governor's disaster declaration,</u> 3 <u>an election official of a political subdivision may not alter any</u> 4 <u>voting standard, practice, or procedure in a manner not otherwise</u> 5 <u>expressly authorized by this code.</u>

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
