5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Sections 11.159(c) and (e), Education Code, are
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(c) The State Board of Education shall require a trustee to
9	complete every two years at least:
10	(1) three hours of training on evaluating student
11	academic performance; [and]
12	(2) one hour of training on identifying and reporting
13	potential victims of sexual abuse, human trafficking, and other
14	maltreatment of children; and
15	(3) two hours of training in cultural competence and
16	<pre>implicit bias.</pre>
17	(e) For purposes of this section:

- (1) "Cultural competence" means the ability to address 18
- the educational needs of individuals from diverse backgrounds 19
- effectively by applying knowledge, empathy, and insight into the 20
- 21 views on education that those backgrounds present.
- (2) "Implicit bias" means: 22
- 23 (A) bias in judgment or behavior that results
- from subtle cognitive processes, including implicit attitudes and 24

- 1 implicit stereotypes, that often operate at a level below conscious
- 2 awareness and without intentional control; or
- 3 (B) implicit attitudes and stereotypes that
- 4 result in beliefs or simple associations that a person makes
- 5 between an object and its evaluation that are automatically
- 6 activated by the mere presence, actual or symbolic, of the attitude
- 7 <u>object.</u>
- 8 (3) "Other[, "other] maltreatment" has the meaning
- 9 assigned by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by
- 11 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (h-1) to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 (h) Continuing education requirements for a superintendent
- 14 must include at least:
- 15 (1) 2-1/2 hours of training every five years on
- 16 identifying and reporting potential victims of sexual abuse, human
- 17 trafficking, and other maltreatment of children; and
- 18 (2) two hours of training every five years in cultural
- 19 competence and implicit bias.
- 20 (h-1) For purposes of this section:
- 21 (1) "Cultural competence" and "implicit bias" have the
- 22 meanings assigned by Section 11.159.
- 23 (2) "Other [this subsection, "other] maltreatment"
- 24 has the meaning assigned by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- 25 SECTION 3. A superintendent subject to continuing education
- 26 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is
- 27 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements

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- 1 described by Section 21.054(h), Education Code, as amended by this
- 2 Act, for any continuing education requirements period that ends
- 3 before January 1, 2023.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
