- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 545.3075 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.3075. OVERNIGHT PARKING OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR
- 8 VEHICLE NEAR CERTAIN APARTMENT COMPLEXES. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Apartment complex" means two or more dwellings in
- 10 one or more buildings that are owned by the same owner, located on
- 11 the same lot or tract, and managed by the same owner, agent, or
- 12 management company.
- 13 (2) "Commercial motor vehicle" has the meaning
- 14 assigned by Section 545.307.
- 15 (b) This section applies only to a county or municipality
- 16 with a population of more than 220,000.
- 17 (c) The owner or manager of an apartment complex may make a
- 18 request to a county or municipality in which the apartment complex
- 19 is located for the posting of official signs prohibiting the
- 20 parking of a commercial motor vehicle in a public right-of-way
- 21 adjacent to the complex after 10 p.m. and before 6 a.m. A request
- 22 under this subsection must be signed and in writing.
- 23 <u>(d) A county or municipality receiving a request under</u>
- 24 Subsection (c) may post one or more signs as requested or as the

county or municipality determines to be necessary. 1 2 (e) A sign posted under Subsection (d) must: (1) be posted in the public right-of-way: 3 4 (A) not more than 10 feet from the property line 5 of the apartment complex; and 6 (B) facing the roadway; and 7 (2) include: 8 (A) a statement, in letters at least two inches 9 in height, that parking of a commercial motor vehicle is prohibited from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. in the public right-of-way or portion of the 10 public right-of-way; and 11 12 (B) arrows clearly indicating the area of the public right-of-way subject to the parking restriction. 13 (f) This section does not apply to a vehicle owned by a 14 15 commercial establishment that is parked in the public right-of-way adjacent to the property where the establishment is located. 16

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
