A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the posting of certain parking signs in a public right-of-way by a local government.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G. Chapter 545, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 545.3075 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 545.3075. (a) A county or municipality with a population greater than 220,000 may accept a written request for

- population greater than 220,000 may accept a written request for the posting of signs that regulate parking of commercial motor vehicles, as defined by Section 545.307, in a public right-of-way adjacent to commercial property after 10 p.m. and before 6 a.m., if the request is signed by the owner or managing member of a commercial property who operates a business on the property.
- 14 (b) A county or municipality that receives a request meeting
 15 the requirements of this section may post signs as requested, or as
 16 determined necessary by the county or municipality, in a public
 17 right-of-way that is within ten feet of a property line that is
 18 adjacent to the right-of-way.
- 19 (c) In the event that a county or municipality receives
 20 requests under subsection (a) for the posting of signs described
 21 under this section from two or more people sharing a common property
 22 line, the county or municipality may post signs as necessary in a
 23 public right-of-way that is adjacent to one or more of those
 24 properties in accordance with Subsection (b).

- 1 (d) A sign posted under this section must:
- 2 (1) state, in letters at least two inches in height,
- 3 that overnight parking of a commercial motor vehicle is restricted
- 4 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. in the right-of-way, or a portion of the
- 5 right-of-way;
- 6 (2) display arrows that properly delineate the area
- 7 subject to parking restriction; and
- 8 (3) be placed facing a public roadway giving access to
- 9 the right-of-way.
- 10 (e) This section does not apply to a vehicle owned by a
- 11 commercial establishment that is parked on the street adjacent to
- 12 where the establishment is located.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
