- 6 SECTION 1. Section 420.045, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 420.045. REPORT OF UNANALYZED EVIDENCE OF SEXUAL
- 9 ASSAULT OR OTHER SEX OFFENSE. (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Backlog kit" means an evidence collection kit
- 11 that has been in the possession of a public accredited crime
- 12 laboratory for more than 90 days.
- 13 (2) "Unsubmitted kit" means an evidence collection kit
- 14 in a law enforcement agency's possession that has not yet been
- 15 submitted to a public accredited crime laboratory.
- 16 (b) Each law enforcement agency [and public accredited
- 17 crime laboratory] shall submit a quarterly report to the department
- 18 identifying the number of <u>unsubmitted kits in the law enforcement</u>
- 19 <u>agency's possession.</u>
- (c) Each public accredited crime laboratory shall submit a
- 21 quarterly report to the department identifying the number of
- 22 evidence collection kits [that the law enforcement agency has not
- 23 yet submitted for laboratory analysis or] for which the crime
- 24 laboratory has not yet completed an analysis, including the number

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
