Section 545.401, Transportation Code, is amended 22 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 23 follows: 24 Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an offense under (b)

1 this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed
2 \$200.

3 <u>(b-1) If an</u> [An] offense under this section resulted in 4 bodily injury or property damage, the offense is a misdemeanor 5 punishable by:

6 (1) a fine not to exceed \$200;

7 (2) confinement in county jail for not more than 308 days; or

(3) both the fine and the confinement.

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 14 15 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 16 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 17

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
