A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring an employee of the legislature to resign on
- 3 becoming a candidate for a seat in the legislature.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 301, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 301.044 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.044. RESIGNATION OF EMPLOYMENT ON BECOMING
- 8 LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATE. If an employee of either house of the
- 9 <u>legislature</u> announces the employee's candidacy, or becomes a
- 10 candidate, for a seat in the house of representatives or the senate,
- 11 the announcement or candidacy constitutes an automatic resignation
- 12 <u>from the employee's position.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
