## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 1001.1101 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1001.1101. INFORMATION RELATING TO PASSING CERTAIN
- 9 VEHICLES. (a) The commission by rule shall require that
- 10 information relating to the requirements of Section 545.157,
- 11 Transportation Code, concerning the passing of certain vehicles be
- 12 <u>included in the curriculum of each driver education course or</u>
- 13 <u>driving safety course.</u>
- 14 (b) In developing rules under this section, the commission
- 15 shall consult with the Department of Public Safety.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
- 17 is amended by adding Section 201.623 to read as follows:
- Sec. 201.623. MOVE OVER OR SLOW DOWN CAMPAIGN. (a) The
- 19 department shall develop and implement a move over or slow down
- 20 public awareness campaign designed to promote compliance with and
- 21 improve public awareness of the requirements of Section 545.157
- 22 concerning the passing of certain vehicles.
- 23 (b) The department may consult and coordinate with the
- 24 Department of Public Safety and the Texas Department of Motor

- 1 Vehicles as the department considers necessary to develop or
- 2 implement the campaign.
- 3 (c) In implementing the campaign, the department may engage
- 4 in online advocacy, issue public service announcements, distribute
- 5 materials, and post signage on roadways relating to the campaign.
- 6 (d) The department may pay the costs of the campaign and its
- 7 <u>administration from:</u>
- 8 (1) gifts, grants, or donations;
- 9 (2) matching funds; and
- 10 (3) other funds made available for that purpose,
- 11 including available department revenue.
- 12 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than May 1, 2022, the Texas
- 13 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules
- 14 required by Section 1001.1101, Education Code, as added by this
- 15 Act.
- 16 (b) Each driver education or driving safety course held on
- 17 or after September 1, 2022, shall include in the course's
- 18 curriculum the information required by the rules adopted under
- 19 Section 1001.1101, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
