(a) The commission by rule shall require that information relating to the requirements of Section 545.157, 10 Transportation Code, concerning the passing of certain vehicles be 11 12 included in the curriculum of each driver education course or driving safety course. 13 14 (b) In developing rules under this section, the commission shall consult with the Department of Public Safety. 15 16 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 201.623 to read as follows: 17 18 Sec. 201.623. MOVE OVER OR SLOW DOWN CAMPAIGN. (a) The department shall develop and implement a move over or slow down 19 20 public awareness campaign designed to promote compliance with and 21 improve public awareness of the requirements of Section 545.157 concerning the passing of certain vehicles. 22 (b) The department may consult and coordinate with the 23 Department of Public Safety and the Texas Department of Motor 24

Vehicles as the department considers necessary to develop or 1 implement the campaign. 2 3 (c) In implementing the campaign, the department may engage in online advocacy, issue public service announcements, distribute 4 5 materials, and post signage on roadways relating to the campaign. 6 (d) The department may pay the costs of the campaign and its 7 administration from: 8 (1) gifts, grants, or donations; 9 (2) matching funds; and (3) other funds made available for that purpose, 10 including available department revenue. 11 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than March 1, 2022, the Texas 12 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules 13 required by Section 1001.1101, Education Code, as added by this 14 15 Act. Not later than September 1, 2022, each provider of a 16 (b) 17 driver education course or driving safety course shall submit the curriculum adopted pursuant to Section 1001.1101, Education Code, 18 as added by this Act, to the Texas Commission of Licensing and 19 Regulation for approval. 20 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
