Section 478.0051(b)(1) does 11 apply to an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(H) 12 not [478.0001(3)(C)]. If an endorsing municipality or endorsing county 13 requests the office to make a determination under Section 478.0102 14 15 for an event described by Section <u>478.0001(3)(H)</u> [478.0001(3)(G)], the remaining provisions of this chapter apply to that event as if 16 17 the event satisfied the eligibility requirements under Section 478.0051(b)(1). 18 SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails 19 over another Act of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, 20 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted 21 22 codes.
