- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 32.053, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsections (b) and (e) and adding Subsections (b-1)
- 6 and (e-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules as
- 8 necessary to implement this section. In adopting rules, the
- 9 executive commissioner shall:
- 10 (1) use the Bienvivir Senior Health Services of El
- 11 Paso initiative as a model for the program;
- 12 (2) ensure that a person is not required to hold a
- 13 certificate of authority as a health maintenance organization under
- 14 Chapter 843, Insurance Code, to provide services under the PACE
- 15 program;
- 16 (3) ensure that participation in the PACE program is
- 17 available as an alternative to enrollment in a Medicaid managed
- 18 care plan under Chapter 533, Government Code, for eligible
- 19 recipients, including recipients eligible for assistance under
- 20 both the medical assistance and Medicare programs;
- 21 (4) ensure that the commission's enrollment broker
- 22 complies with the requirement under Subsection (b-1) to notify
- 23 recipients about the PACE program and refer those recipients, as
- 24 appropriate, to corresponding program sites;

- 21 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 25 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 26 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
