H.B. No. 3372

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring school districts and open-enrollment charter
3 schools to post the annual compensation of the superintendent or
4 chief executive officer on the district's or school's Internet
5 website.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 11.201, Education Code, is amended by
8 adding Subsection (b-3) to read as follows:

9 (b-3) A school district that maintains an Internet website
10 shall post on the district's website through a clearly identifiable
11 link that appears in a prominent place on the home page of the
12 website the annual compensation received by the superintendent,
13 including a list of each amount paid by the district as:

14 (1) an annual salary;

15 (2) a bonus;

16 (3) a benefit; or

17 (4) an allowance or stipend for technology, housing,
18 transportation, or other miscellaneous expenses.

19 SECTION 2. Section 12.136, Education Code, is amended to
20 read as follows:

21 Sec. 12.136. POSTING OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER
22 COMPENSATION [~~SALARY~~]. An open-enrollment charter school shall
23 post on the school's Internet website through a clearly
24 identifiable link that appears in a prominent place on the home page

1 of the website the annual compensation received by [~~salary of~~] the
2 school's superintendent or, as applicable, of the administrator
3 serving as educational leader and chief executive officer,
4 including a list of each amount paid by the school as:

- 5 (1) an annual salary;
- 6 (2) a bonus;
- 7 (3) a benefit; or
- 8 (4) an allowance or stipend for technology, housing,
9 transportation, or other miscellaneous expenses.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
