Sections 6.14(e-3) and (e-4), Article 6243a-1, 5 Revised Statutes, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (e-3) The board may by rule allow <u>any person receiving an</u> annuity from the annuitization of a DROP account under this section 8 [a DROP participant who has terminated active service and who is 9 eligible for a retirement pension] to: 10 11 (1)assign the distribution from the person's 12 [participant's] annuitized DROP account to a third party provided the pension system receives a favorable private letter ruling from 13 14 the Internal Revenue Service ruling that such an assignment will not negatively impact the pension system's qualified plan status; 15 16 and subject to Subsection (e-4) of this section, in 17 (2) 18 the event of a financial hardship that was not reasonably foreseeable obtain a lump-sum distribution from the person's 19 20 [participant's] DROP account resulting in a corresponding 21 reduction in the total number or in the amount of annuity payments. 22 (e-4) The board shall adopt rules necessary to implement 23 Subsection (e-3)(2) of this section, including rules regarding what 24 constitutes a financial hardship for purposes of that subdivision.

1 In adopting the rules, the board shall provide flexibility to 2 persons receiving an annuity from the annuitization of a DROP 3 <u>account</u> [members].

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
