- 17 (5) an appeal of a judgment in a condemnation
- proceeding, including an appeal of an assessment of damages; and 18
- 19 (6) submit to the appraisal district office in the
- county in which the property is taxable a report of decreased value 20
- 21 for the owner's remaining property after the taking.
- 22 (c) The statement must include:
- 23 (1) the title, "Landowner's Bill of Rights"; [and]
- 24 (2) a description of:

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- 1 (A) the condemnation procedure provided by
- 2 Chapter 21, Property Code;
- 3 (B) the condemning entity's obligations to the
- 4 property owner; and
- 5 (C) the property owner's options during a
- 6 condemnation, including the property owner's right to object to and
- 7 appeal an amount of damages awarded; and
- 8 (3) a copy of the report of decreased value form issued
- 9 by the comptroller.
- 10 SECTION 2. The office of the attorney general shall make the
- 11 landowner's bill of rights statement required by Section 402.031,
- 12 Government Code, as amended by this Act, available on the attorney
- 13 general's Internet website not later than January 1, 2022.
- 14 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 15 section, this Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
- 16 (b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
