BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 402.031(b) and (c), Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) The landowner's bill of rights must notify each property owner that the property owner has the right to: 8 notice of the proposed acquisition of the owner's 9 (1) 10 property; a bona fide good faith effort to negotiate by the 11 (2) 12 entity proposing to acquire the property; 13 (3) an assessment of damages to the owner that will 14 result from the taking of the property; 15 (4) a hearing under Chapter 21, Property Code, including a hearing on the assessment of damages; [and] 16 appeal of a judgment in a condemnation 17 (5) an proceeding, including an appeal of an assessment of damages; and 18 (6) submit to the appraisal district office in the 19 county in which the property is taxable a report of decreased value 20 for the owner's remaining property after the taking. 21 (c) The statement must include: 22 (1) the title, "Landowner's Bill of Rights"; [and] 23 24 (2) a description of:

The office of the attorney general shall make the 10 landowner's bill of rights statement required by Section 402.031, 11 Government Code, as amended by this Act, available on the attorney 12 general's Internet website not later than January 1, 2022. 13 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this 14 15 section, this Act takes effect January 1, 2022. 16 (b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
