1 AN ACT 2 relating to information regarding state agency vehicle fleets. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. The heading to Section 2171.101, Government 4 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 2171.101. VEHICLE REPORTING SYSTEM; EXCEPTION. SECTION 2. Section 2171.101, Government Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 8 9 follows: The office of vehicle fleet management shall establish a 10 (a) 11 vehicle reporting system to assist [each] state agencies [agency] 12 in the management of agency [its] vehicle fleets [fleet]. Except as provided by Subsection (d), a [A] state agency shall [be required 13 14 to] submit vehicle fleet [the] reports on a quarterly basis, not earlier than the 45th day or later than the 60th day after the date 15 on which the quarter ends. 16 (d) A state agency with a fleet of more than 2,500 vehicles 17 shall establish and maintain a vehicle reporting system to assist 18 the agency in the management of the agency's vehicle fleet. Not 19 later than October 15 of each year, the agency shall submit to the 20 21 office of vehicle fleet management the information the office requests regarding the agency's vehicle fleet for the previous 22 23 state fiscal year. The agency may provide the information in the 24 format used by the agency's reporting system. The agency is exempt

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1	from paying to the office any fee for maintaining the vehicle
2	reporting system established under Subsection (a).
3	SECTION 3. Section 2205.036(c), Government Code, is amended
4	to read as follows:
5	(c) The department may not provide aircraft transportation
6	to a destination unless:
7	(1) the destination is not served by a commercial
8	carrier;
9	(2) the aircraft transportation is the most
10	cost-effective travel arrangement in accordance with Section
11	660.007(a);
12	(3) the time required to use a commercial carrier
13	interferes with passenger obligations;
14	(4) a representative of the Department of Public
15	Safety determines that security concerns for a passenger warrant
16	the use of a state aircraft;
17	(5) the number of passengers traveling makes the use
18	of a state aircraft cost-effective; or
19	(6) [(4)] emergency circumstances necessitate the use
20	of a state aircraft.
21	SECTION 4. Each state agency subject to Section
22	2171.101(d), Government Code, as added by this Act, shall:
23	(1) establish a vehicle reporting system for the
24	agency's vehicle fleet not later than October 1, 2021; and
25	(2) submit the report required by that subsection to
26	the office of vehicle fleet management not later than October 15,
27	2021, or a later date determined by the office.

1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
