## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the Texas Commission on Fire 3 Protection.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 419.004, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 7 follows:

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(a) The commission is composed of the following 13 members:

two members to be selected from a list of five 9 (1)names submitted by the Texas Fire Chiefs Association who are chief 10 11 officers with a minimum rank that is equivalent to the position 12 immediately below that of the fire chief and who are employed in fire departments as defined by Section 419.021 that are under the 13 14 jurisdiction of the commission, at least one of whom must be the head of a fire department and one of whom must be employed by a 15 political subdivision with a population of less than 100,000; 16

(2) two members to be selected from a list of five names submitted by the Texas State Association of Fire Fighters who are fire protection personnel as defined by Section 419.021 with the rank of battalion chief or below and who are employed in fire departments or other appropriate local authorities under the jurisdiction of the commission, one of whom must be employed by a political subdivision with a population of less than 100,000;

24 (3) two members to be selected from a list of five

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1 names submitted by the State Firemen's and Fire Marshals' 2 Association of Texas who are volunteer fire chiefs or volunteer 3 fire fighters;

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4 (4) <u>one member who is a chief officer with a minimum</u>
5 <u>rank that is equivalent to the position immediately below that of</u>
6 <u>the fire chief, who is employed in a fire department as defined by</u>
7 <u>Section 419.021 that is under the jurisdiction of the commission</u>
8 <u>and that serves a population of 100,000 or more;</u>

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(5) one certified fire protection engineer;

10 [(5) one certified arson investigator or certified
11 fire protection inspector;]

12 (6) one fire protection instructor from an institution 13 of higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code; 14 and

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(7) four public members.

16 <u>(a-1) One of the commission members must be a certified</u>
17 arson investigator or certified fire protection inspector.

SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to the 18 qualifications of members of the Texas Commission on Fire 19 Protection do not affect the entitlement of a member serving on the 20 commission immediately before the effective date of this Act to 21 22 continue as a member of the commission for the remainder of the member's term. The changes in law apply only to a member appointed 23 24 on or after the effective date of this Act. This Act does not prohibit a person who is a member of the commission on the effective 25 26 date of this Act from being reappointed to the commission if the person has the qualifications required for a member under Section 27
