6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 418.060 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 418.060. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT WAREHOUSES.
9	(a) In this section, "personal protective equipment" means
10	specialized clothing or equipment worn for protection against
11	hazardous materials related to a disaster, including communicable
12	and other infectious diseases.
13	(b) The division shall maintain at least six
14	climate-controlled warehouses to store personal protective
15	equipment for disaster response in this state, including public
16	health disasters and communicable or infectious disease
17	emergencies. The warehouses must be:
18	(1) capable of protecting personal protective
19	equipment from damage by the elements and other environmental
20	conditions, including temperature, humidity, light, and airflow,
21	as necessary to preserve the equipment stored in the warehouse; and
22	(2) located throughout this state so that personal
23	protective equipment can be delivered from a warehouse to any
24	location in this state within six hours.
