- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter C, Chapter 2051,
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER C. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION IN NEWSPAPER; INTERNET
- 8 ALTERNATIVE
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2051.042(a), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:

- 11 (a) This subchapter applies only to notice that is required
- 12 or authorized by law other than this subchapter to be published in a
- 13 newspaper. If a governmental entity or representative does not
- 14 choose to post notice on an Internet website under Section
- 15 2051.0421, this subchapter applies only to the extent that the
- 16 other [general or special] law requiring or authorizing the
- 17 publication of a notice in a newspaper [by a governmental entity or
- 18 representative] does not specify the manner of the publication,
- 19 including the number of times that the notice is required to be
- 20 published and the period during which the notice is required to be
- 21 published.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 2051, Government Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 2051.0421 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2051.0421. INTERNET POSTING ALTERNATIVE FOR NOTICE

- 1 REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED IN NEWSPAPER. (a) Notwithstanding any
- 2 other law and except as provided by Section 2051.042(b), a
- 3 governmental entity or representative required by other law to
- 4 provide notice by publication in a newspaper may, as an
- 5 alternative, satisfy that requirement by posting the notice on the
- 6 governmental entity's or representative's Internet website.
- 7 (b) Internet website notice posted as an alternative to
- 8 required publication of notice in a newspaper as authorized by this
- 9 section:
- 10 (1) to the extent possible, must meet requirements
- 11 provided by law for the publication of the newspaper notice that can
- 12 be applied to an Internet website posting, including requirements
- 13 related to the timing, duration, content, and appearance of the
- 14 notice; and
- 15 (2) is not required to meet requirements provided by
- 16 law for the publication of the newspaper notice that by their nature
- 17 cannot be applied to an Internet website posting, including
- 18 requirements relating to circulation.
- 19 (c) This subchapter may not be construed to require a
- 20 governmental entity or representative that chooses the alternative
- 21 Internet posting under this section to also publish notice in a
- 22 <u>newspaper.</u>
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
