1-21 relating to the authority of a county to require photo
 1-22 identification to file certain documents with the county clerk.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 191.010, Local Government
 1-25 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 191.010. AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO
 1-27 FILE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS [~~IN CERTAIN COUNTIES~~].

1-28 SECTION 2. Section 191.010(b), Local Government Code, is
 1-29 amended to read as follows:

1-30 (b) A county clerk [~~in a county with a population of 3.3~~
 1-31 ~~million or more~~] may require a person presenting a document in
 1-32 person for filing in the real property records of the county to
 1-33 present a photo identification to the clerk. The clerk may copy the
 1-34 photo identification or record information from the photo
 1-35 identification. The clerk may not charge a person a fee to copy or
 1-36 record the information from a photo identification.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
